



Distracted driving disproportionately affects younger drivers, with nearly 60% of their crashes caused by distraction. Teens are almost three times as likely to die in distracted driving crashes as their parents.

More than 10,000 people are killed each year in the U.S. by distracted driving. I don't want to ever be responsible for killing someone while driving.

- Obey posted speed limits.
- Respectfully speak up when I see others driving distracted.
